

# Sectigo Certificate Regulations

## § 1 Definitions

1. Certificate: A digital encryption key that satisfies security requirements for cryptography. It is linked to the subscriber information provided at the time of order and is valid for a year.
2. Certifying Organization: A domestic or international organization with the authority to issue certificates.
3. Subscriber: A person or business that uses WEBD.pl services and is registered in the WEBD.pl customer database.
4. WEBD.pl: The service's owner, Globtel Internet Szymon Hersztek, located at ul. Matecznikowa 2/1 80-126 Gdańsk, VAT NUMBER: PL9570804786, REGON: 192519144, sells services via WEBD.pl.
5. Sectigo: Sectigo Limited, located at Unit 7 Listerhills Science Park, Campus Road, Bradford, West Yorkshire, England, BD7 1HR, is also in charge of handling requests for certificates.

## § 2 General provisions

1. WEBD.pl acts as an intermediary in the certificate issuance process. It is not a certification authority, does not issue certificates, and does not grant rights to use certificates.

2. The entity responsible for processing certificate issuance requests is Sectigo Limited, located at Unit 7 Listerhills Science Park, Campus Road, Bradford, West Yorkshire, England, BD7 1HR, which the Subscriber agrees to.
3. WEBD.pl does not guarantee the issuance of a certificate. The decision to issue a certificate is made solely by the certification organisations.
4. Any comments or complaints related to the issuance of a certificate should be directed directly to the certification organisation.
5. By purchasing a certificate, the Subscriber agrees to authorize WEBD.pl to represent them before Sectigo, and is obligated to review Sectigo terms and conditions: <https://www.sectigo.com/uploads/files/Certificate-Subscriber-Agreement-2.7-click.pdf>
6. Paying for the certificate is equivalent to accepting this regulation, the [WEBD.pl service terms](#), and the Sectigo terms.
7. The subscriber agrees to the processing of their personal data by WEBD.pl. They also consent to the transfer of personal data to Sectigo Limited, Unit 7 Listerhills Science Park, Campus Road, Bradford, West Yorkshire, England, BD7 1HR for the purpose of issuing the certificate.

### **§ 3 Terms of Service**

1. In order to verify the data required for the certificate request, WEBD.pl may ask the subscriber for:
  - a. Delivery of additional documents within 2 days, related to the content provided in the order, which are the basis for the certificate request and required by certification authorities;
  - b. Corrections or changes to the data provided by the subscriber within 2 days;
  - c. Submission of additional data or statements required to process the certificate request within 2 days.

2. WEBD.pl has the right to suspend the processing of the certificate request until the above data is provided.
3. The subscriber is fully liable to WEBD.pl for any damages caused by providing unverifiable or false data, based on which WEBD.pl processed the certificate request.
4. After placing the order, the subscriber is required to make the payment according to the pro forma invoice provided, within the deadline specified on the invoice.
5. The subscriber must complete the necessary steps to validate their data with the certifying organization within 14 days of activating the paid order. If the subscriber does not do this on time, the certificate order will be revoked.
6. The certificate's subscription period begins from the moment the certificate is issued by the certification authority.
7. After the certificate is issued, the subscriber cannot change the name of the certified domain.
8. WEBD.pl is not responsible for the consequences of the certificate's expiration or the failure to issue a new certificate to the subscriber.
9. The subscriber declares that they have read the regulations defining the terms of certificate issuance published by the certification authorities. The subscriber agrees to comply with these regulations throughout the entire subscription period of the issued certificate.
10. WEBD.pl will provide the conditions under which a certification authority issues certificates upon the subscribers request.
11. If WEBD.pl incurs any costs as a result of the subscribers actions, for which WEBD.pl assumes the responsibility of properly fulfilling the obligation towards the certification authority, or any other costs towards government authorities arising from the subscribers actions or omissions (operational costs, contractual penalties, administrative fees, disciplinary fines, and others), WEBD.pl has the right to impose a contractual penalty on the subscriber equal to the costs incurred by WEBD.pl.

#### **§ 4 Processing of Personal Data**

1. The scope and purpose of personal data processing by WEBD.pl are outlined in the [WEBD.pl Privacy Policy](#), which is an integral part of these Terms and Conditions.
2. WEBD.pl determines the purposes and methods of processing the subscribers personal data and is the data controller. The processing of the subscribers regular personal data is carried out in accordance with the provisions of the European Parliament and Council Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016, on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU L 119, p. 1) (hereinafter: GDPR), considering the provisions of the Electronic Services Act and other generally applicable legal regulations.
3. The scope and purpose of personal data processing by Sectigo are outlined in the Sectigo terms and conditions.

#### **§ 5 Final Provisions**

1. In matters not covered by these Sectigo Certificate Terms and Conditions, the provisions of the WEBD.pl Terms of Service available on [www.webd.pl](http://www.webd.pl) and applicable legal regulations shall apply.
